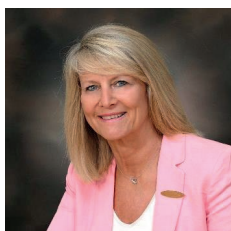


Captains Drive in

Energy Efficiency Assessment

As we have explained recently, the club’s energy costs have been increasing significantly in recent years.

In response to this, one of our members, Paul Jackson, volunteered to help the club by looking at ways in which our energy costs can be managed more effectively. Working with the Marches Energy Partnership, Paul has commissioned an Energy Efficiency Assessment which looked at various ways in which our energy usage and costs can be reduced.

The resulting comprehensive report, completed at no cost to the club, identifies several areas where significant efficiencies could be achieved, and these are being considered by the Board. As you would expect, there are costs associated with implementing these energy efficiency measures, which the Board will need to consider when prioritising future investment. We will also investigate the potential for grant funding for some of this work.

The Board would like to thank Paul for his work to date, and for any future assistance that may arise from decisions that we take.
